

Italy: The Italian government extends the digital services tax ('DST') deadlines

The Italian government has announced in a press release that the deadlines for the Italian DST due for FY2020 have been extended.

The deadlines for FY 2020 were originally 16 February 2021 for the payment of the tax and 31 March 2021 for the submission of the annual return. However, the Italian government announced last night that the original deadlines have been moved. The new deadlines are as follows:

- 16 March 2021: payment of DST due for FY 2020;
- 30 April 2021: submission of the annual DST return.
