Italy: VAT measures postponed due to the COVID-19 emergency

The 1 April deadline for retailers to update their cash registers has been postponed to 1 October.

Pre-populated VAT ledgers and VAT returns for resident taxpayers will be available for transactions dating from July 2021 and January 2022 respectively.

Through instructions (no. 83884/2021) published yesterday, the Italian Revenue Agency has postponed once again the adoption of the new technical specifications (version 7.0) for the transmission of daily payment details (this follows a previous postponement earlier this year from 1 January to 1 April 2021). The new technical specifications, which were supposed to enter into force tomorrow 1 April, will be effective from 1 October 2021 and therefore cash registers (*'registratori telematici*) must be updated by 30 September 2021.

Moreover, the Italian government recently postponed the provision of prepopulated documents for taxpayers resident or established in Italy. The Italian Revenue Agency will now:

- make draft VAT ledgers and periodical VAT settlements available for transactions carried out from 1 July 2021 onwards;
- make draft VAT returns available for transactions carried out from 1 January 2022 onwards.
